2.120.020 Membership.

(B) Each Supervisor shall nominate one person who may reside within the Supervisor's district. Each nominee shall also reside within the jurisdiction of the County Fire Department, except for the Fourth District Supervisor's nominee.

It has come to my attention that Carey Pico, FDAC Commissioner for District 2, does not live within the jurisdiction of the County Fire Department. Mr. Pico resides in the Central Fire Service Area, which as far as I know, is not part of County Fire.

This is a known issue to the FDAC. Just last year, Abby Young was appointed by district 1 and could not serve due to this same eligibility requirement.

Could this be explained to the public?

In addition, John Walker, 4th District Commissioner has not attended meetings for over 2 years. How is that acceptable?
